<b>Stand up!</b>	Niibawin!	Nii ba win

<b>Go away or Leave!</b>	Maajaan!	Maa jaan
<b>Build a fire!</b>	Boodawen!	Boo da wen
<b>Go Home!</b>	Giiwen!	Gii wen
<b>Sing!</b>	Nagamon!	Na ga mon
<b>Go to sleep!</b>	Nibaan!	Ni baan

**Plural Imperatives: Words that “tell” more than one person what to do**

<b>Come in! (pl)</b>	Biindigeyok!	Biin di ge yok
<b>Sit down! (pl)</b>	Namadabiyok!	Na ma da bi yok
<b>Stand up! (pl)</b>	Niibawiyok!	Nii ba wi yok
<b>Come here! (pl)</b>	Biizhaayok!	Bii zhaa yok
<b>Go away or Leave! (pl)</b>	Maajaayok!	Maa jaa yok
<b>Build a fire! (pl)</b>	Boodaweyok!	Boo da we yok
<b>Go Home! (pl)</b>	Giiweyok!	Gii we yok
